

# Level 3 Landscape or Horticulture Supervisor Apprenticeship

<b>Qualification</b>	Apprenticeship Level 3 Horticulture and Landscape Operative (Standard ST0225)
<b>Based at</b>	Hadlow College
<b>Length of apprenticeship</b>	27 - 30 months
<b>Hours</b>	Part time study includes one day a month at college.
<b>Entry requirements</b>	GCSE in Maths and English at grade 4 /C
<b>Description</b>	<p>The broad purpose of the apprenticeship is to plan, oversee and carry out horticultural or landscaping operations to create and maintain horticultural spaces. The work involves both the soft landscaping aspects (plants and soil) and the hard landscaping (surfaces, features, and structures).</p> <p>Horticulture or Landscaping Supervisors will be employed in an occupation that specialises in either horticulture or landscaping.</p> <p>Horticultural Supervisors plan the maintenance of established horticultural areas. They oversee and carry out hard and soft landscaping maintenance operations and ensure that the site is maintained in line with the design, purpose and business objectives. They will have an advanced skill set, enabling them to undertake a wide range of horticultural operations.</p> <p>Landscaping Supervisors will plan, oversee and undertake activities required to install landscapes to meet customer specifications. This might be complex landscapes with high values and a range of features including ornamental, horizontal and vertical structures, or smaller scale domestic gardens such as patios, retaining walls, water features, decking or pergolas.</p> <p>Horticulture or Landscape Supervisors will require certificates of competence and or training to undertake particular activities and use specialist machinery.</p> <p>As part of this course the apprentice will undertake a PA1 and PA6 spraying licence and a Level 3 emergency first aid certificate.</p>
<b>Assessment</b>	Professional discussion based on apprentices portfolio, online knowledge test, practical assessment and supervisory studies project
<b>Progression</b>	Upon finishing this course the student can progress into industry into a supervisory role of managing teams. Students can also progress onto the Level 5 Technical Manager Apprenticeship.
