Important Event Information

Ticket Information

Once you have purchased a ticket, you will be permitted entry onto site in the time you have purchased. You will be able to stay for as long as you like and enjoy the rides, stalls and of course meet our lovely new-born lambs!

Event Parking

Disabled parking will be located on Bourne Grange Lane by Garrad House and you will be able to take the shuttle bus over to the event. Please note: wheelchairs may not be suitable for the event due to uneven surfaces located throughout the event.

All other visitors please head to Ashes Lane and follow the signage to the main car parking field - you will need to be checked-in at the gate.

COVID-19 Guidance

Should Government policy change about outdoor gatherings / events we reserve the right to cancel this event. If this is unfortunately the case we will notify those who have shown interest via email.

Health & Safety

- First Aid facilities and first aiders will be available on site at all times.
- Members of the public are not allowed to handle the lambs and sheep due to the risk of biological infection. Purposely touching any of the animals is done so at your own risk and you are advised to use the hand wash and sanitising facilities as soon as you can
- Pregnant women are advised not to enter the site as there is a risk to the unborn child of biological exposure from touching animals/animal faeces.
- Eating food whilst in the Lambing sheds is not permitted.
- Hand wash facilities and sanitising dispensers are situated around the site for your convenience.
- For everyone's enjoyment the site is a no smoking area - which includes e-cigarettes and vaping devices, other than designated smoking shelters.
- Beware of any uneven surfaces and barbed wire fences.
- No dogs allowed, other than guide or assistance dogs.

Payments

- Card and Cash payments will be accepted on the gate for walk-ins (limited availability).

Due to the nature of the event location, we suggest a mixture of cash and card payments to allow for any signal disturbances on the day.

Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. What time does the event start and finish?** The event runs from 11:00 am – 4:00pm.
- 2. Where do I need to park if I am a visitor?** Ashes Lane, Main Car Parking Field - please follow directional signage on the day.
- 3. Where do I need to park if I require disabled parking?** Main College Entrance, down Bourne Grange Lane by Garrad House.
- 4. Where do I need to park if I am a stallholder?** Once you have set up your stall, you must park in Ashes Lane, Main Car Parking Field.
- 5. Do I need to pay to enter?** Yes, tickets can be purchased here www.eventbrite.co.uk/e/lambing-weekend-tickets-251974802417
- 6. Can I bring my own food and drink?** Yes, you can. But there will be many food vendors available for you to purchase food and drink from.
- 7. Can I bring my dog?** Unfortunately, dogs are not permitted at this event, other than guide or assistance dogs.
- 8. What footwear should I wear?** We recommend wearing suitable footwear due to the event location. If it is due to be a rainy day or has been recently, then we would highly recommend wellies.

- 10. Can I get tickets on the day of the event?** We will be taking a selected number of walk-ins, but we cannot guarantee entry – please ensure you pre-register before the event to secure your place.
- 11. Are there any COVID-19 restrictions in place?** If COVID-19 guidance changes from the time pre-registration is published, updates will be sent via email and uploaded on the website. Please respect others when attending the event and use the hand sanitizer located throughout the site.
